

## LIONS HEAD

---

(Reel)

5 x 40 Reel for 5 dancers in a diamond set, 5<sup>th</sup> person in the centre facing 1<sup>st</sup> person

Bars	Description
1-8	1+2+3+4 circle four hands round & back while 5 in the centre dances any suitable reel step.
9-16	1,2 & 5 dance right hands across. 3,4 & 5 dance left hands across.
17-24	5 dances right shoulder around 1 and 2 while 1 & 2 and 3 & 4 turn right hands. 5 dances left shoulder around 3 and 4 while 1 & 2 and 3 & 4 turn left hands. 5 ends facing 1.
25-40	5 and 1 set and ½ turn right hand 1 and 4 set and ½ turn right hand 4 and 3 set and ½ turn right hand 3 and 2 set and ½ turn right hand.  Repeat four times, each time from new positions.

Note: The name of the dance refers to both the mountain Lions Head which along with Table Mountain welcomes visitors to Cape Town, as well as the crest of the Clan Macgregor which is also the Lion's Head. This dance was devised for Judith Macgregor, British High Commissioner to South Africa, to celebrate her visit to the Cape Town Caledonian Society for their Burn's Night Supper.
